Ariana Škrinjar, born September 1989 in Zagreb, Croatia, started playing violin when she was 9 years old.

During her secondary music school she became a member of Zagreb Youth Chamber Orchestra and during her studies at Music Academy in Zagreb she participated in Maribor International Orchestra 2010 and 2011, Mediterranean Youth Orchestra in 2015 and Zagreb Youth Orchestra. Years 2012, 2013 and 2014 she devoted to improving her chamber music skills at the Sarajevo Chamber Music Festival. Before graduating she spent one semester as an exchange student at Fryderyk Chopin University of Music in Warsaw, Poland, in the class of professor Konstanty Andrzej Kulka. In September 2015 she graduated as Master of Music at the Music Academy in Zagreb from the class of professor Anđelko Krpan.

She works as a violin teacher at Music school of Ivan Matetić Ronjgov Rijeka. As an educator she attends seminars and lectures about methods for teaching violin, relaxing techniques and musictherapy and as a violinist she attended seminars with professor Violeta Smailović-Huart.
